### Dress Code

*\*Your appearance is a testimony to the world and to fellow Christians. While maintaining current trends, remember to dress within the Dress Code guidelines.*

**FEMALES** – No bare midriff or low cut shirts, no short skirts/shorts, no explicit/suggestive language or graphic clothing, swimsuit (must be modest one-piece or bring a dark shirt with two-piece)

**MALES** – No sagging pants or exposed undergarments, no explicit/suggestive language or graphic clothing

### Code of Conduct

1. Camper must be on time for all meetings, activities, and meals
2. Camper needs to sleep in order to receive all that God has for them
3. Camper must honor the established music, and video game guidelines: ipads, tablets, headphones, hand-held video games or any other music or video playback/recording devices are **not allowed**
4. **Student may bring their cell phones and can be used with camp counselor's supervision only.**
5. Public display of affection is prohibited
6. Fighting is prohibited
7. Theft is prohibited
8. Camper is not allowed to possess or use tobacco/vape, alcohol, illegal substances, fireworks, firearms, weapons, etc.
9. Camper is not allowed to enter the cabin of the opposite sex at any time
10. Malicious pranks and/or destruction of property are strictly prohibited
11. Water bottle must be attached to lanyard and around neck at all time

### Consequences

**Codes of Conduct 1-4:** These actions will be confronted once and restriction of free time or kitchen/bathroom duty will be assigned if actions are repeated.

**Codes of Conduct 5-10:** These actions will result in being sent home immediately at parent's time & expense. It will be the responsibility of the parent to pick the student up from camp.

**\*All Consequences will be given at Epic Summer Camp Security's discretion and some actions may result in student forfeiting right to attend camp the following year.**

## **CAMP FAQ's**

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This should help you with any question(s) you may have, if not please contact our office.

### **Q. What are the age requirements for youth to attend?**

A. All youth must be between 12-18 years of age at the time of camp in order to attend.

### **Q. Can students sign up individually?**

A. No. We only allow students to come as a part of a youth group. Part of our mission is to equip students to grow in their relationship with their local church body and to learn to use those resources available to them there.

### **Q. Do you accept personal checks?**

A. No. Generations Church and Epic Summer Camp will only accept a business check from the Church attending.

### **Q. Do you offer paintball this year?**

A. Unfortunately, we will not have paintball this year but we will have archery tag as an option this year.

### **Q. Are students allowed to bring their cell phones?**

A. Yes, however they will not be allowed to use their phones except under counselor or leader supervision.

### **Q. Are students allowed to bring their ipads, etc?**

A. Student must honor the established music, and video game guidelines: ipads, tablets, headphones, hand-held video games or any other music or video playback/recording devices are **not allowed**.

### **Q. If a parent needs to contact their son/daughter how do they do so if they are not allowed to use their cell phones?**

A. The Youth Leader should have a contact number for them in the event they need to reach their son/daughter.

### **Q. How can my youth group dance/drama team participate in camp services?**

A. Please contact our office with your team information to our media team and send in a current video of their ministry.

### **Q. Can my student bring a musical instrument?**

A. Anyone can bring a musical instrument at their Youth Leader's discretion. Generations Church and Epic Summer Camp will not be responsible for any damages or loss of such.

**Q. My student needs to have medication. How is this administered?**

A. We will be providing a camp medic to whom all medication must be turned in at our Registration Office at the time of arrival. Please list on paper your teenager's information (i.e. student's name, Church, contact information, medication and instructions).

**Q. One of my students cannot attend but has made a deposit. Can I fill the spot with someone else?**

A. All deposits are non-refundable as outlined in the Registration Procedures. Please advise us when a student has dropped out of camp immediately. If you would like to fill that vacant spot with another student from your group, please contact the camp administrator.

**Q. How big is camp?**

A. Camps have ranged from 7-10 youth groups + 200 campers from California and Mexico

**Q. When are deposits due?**

A. This information is located on the Registration Costs and Payment Schedule page.

**Q. How will I know what our youth group balance is?**

A. Generations Church and Epic Summer Camp Administrator will contact you with the information we have not received when your registrations are due, before the deadline of June 29.

**Q. What time do we arrive on Sunday, July 19th, 2026?**

A. Registration starts at 3:00pm and Dinner is at 5:00pm.

**Q. Do students need to bring cash?**

A. If a student would like to bring cash this is optional. Cash is definitely needed if they would like to purchase snacks at the snack bar. We are also selling our Epic Summer Camp merch and apparel, so if your students would like, they may bring cash to purchase apparel. Also, it is beneficial to the Youth Group if they decide to stop and get food on the way to or from camp. We also offer credit card and tap pay for processing if needed.

**Q. Is there a dress code?**

A. Yes. All camp attire should be modest and appropriate. This information is located in the Registration Procedures and Parent Letter.
